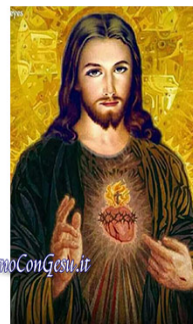

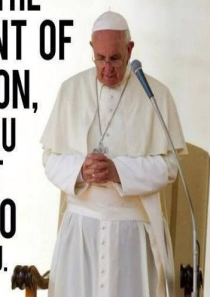

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Yr B

«La gente, chi dice che io sia? Ma voi, chi dite che io sia?» (Vangelo). Gesù pone un duplice quesito: uno su che cosa pensano di lui le folle; un altro su che cosa pensano di lui i discepoli, coloro, cioè, che gli sono più vicini. Sono domande che dobbiamo sentire fatte anche a noi, e solo se sapremo dare ad esse una risposta potrà stabilirsi tra noi e il Cristo un'autentica relazione di vita. Le domande di Gesù esigono una risposta integrale dell'uomo, come a ogni dono di Dio deve corrispondere il dono totale della persona. La comunione con Dio in Cristo Gesù non può, infatti, riferirsi ora a questo, ora a quest'altro aspetto particolare, ma deve riguardare tutto l'uomo, nella totalità del suo atteggiamento esteriore (opere) e nella disposizione interiore in cui vive e opera lo Spirito Santo (fede). La comunione con Dio e il prossimo, per la grazia del battesimo, è un'esistenza nuova, interamente connotata dalla fede, dalla speranza e dalla carità, mediante la quale «il Signore di tutti» guida ogni uomo a lasciarsi coinvolgere dalla sua presenza (Il Lettura). Dio, in Cristo, non è solo "essere", ma è "esserci" che si dona senza condizione, passando attraverso la quotidianità del «qui e ora».

Jesus asks a twofold question: one about what the crowds think of him; another about what the disciples think of him, that is, those closest to him. These are questions that we must also feel are being asked of us, and only if we are able to give an answer to them can an authentic relationship of life be established between us and Christ.

Communion with God and neighbor, through the grace of baptism, is a new existence, entirely characterized by faith, hope and charity, through which "the Lord of all" guides every man to let himself be involved in his presence. God, in Christ, is not only "being", but is "being there" that gives itself unconditionally, passing through the daily life of the "here and now".
