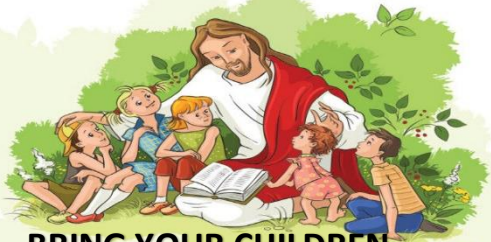

**Sept. 20, 2025 –25<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Today, is a time for reflection on the importance of stewardship and the need to prioritize God over material wealth. The readings and Gospel story of the dishonest steward serve as a reminder that we should not serve both God and money. Instead, we are called to live with honesty, justice, and faithfulness to God above all else. The readings challenge us to live with integrity, care for others, and use our talents and possessions wisely for God's kingdom. The Gospel story teaches us that focusing on wealth and material goods can distort our worldview and lead us to prioritize accumulation over love, grace, and justice.
