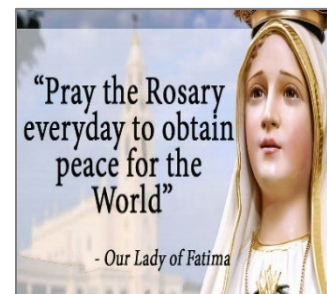



25th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Yr B

Nel Vangelo di oggi, Gesù predice la sua imminente sofferenza, morte e resurrezione. Tuttavia, i discepoli invece di riflettere su ciò che Gesù stava dicendo, erano impegnati a litigare segretamente su chi fosse il più grande. Questo è ciò che vediamo spesso in qualsiasi società, chiesa, famiglia ecc.: l'ambizione personale è più importante di qualsiasi altra cosa. Di conseguenza, segue: lotte intestine, pettegolezzi, minacce alla vita e alle proprietà, odio e ogni sorta di vizio; a scapito del bene comune e della pacifica convivenza. Pertanto, usando un bambino come esempio, Gesù ci insegna che dobbiamo diventare come bambini per essere grandi. Ovviamente questo non significa essere infantili. Piuttosto, significa essere come bambini. Significa che dobbiamo vivere in umile servizio a Dio e gli uni agli altri. Per essere grandi, concentriamoci su qualcosa di diverso da noi stessi. Significa la nostra capacità di accogliere, accogliere e lavorare in armonia con gli altri proprio come fanno sempre i bambini.

In today's gospel, Jesus foretells his imminent suffering, death and resurrection. However, the disciples instead of reflecting on what Jesus was saying, they were busy quarrelling secretly over who was the greatest. This is what we see often in any society, church, family etc.: personal ambition is more important than anything else. Consequently, follows: infighting, gossip, threats to lives and properties, hatred and all sorts of vices; at the expense of the common good and peaceful coexistence.

Therefore, by using a child as an example Jesus teaches us that we have to become like children in order to be great. Of course this does not mean being childish. Rather, it means being child-like. It means that we have to live in humble service to God and to one another. To be great, let us be focused on something other than one self. It means our ability to accommodate, welcome, and work in harmony with others just as children always do. - Fr. Njoku Canice Chukwuemeka
