

**St. Wilfrid** (c. 633 – c. 709) was an English bishop and saint. Born a Northumbrian noble, he entered religious life as a teenager and studied at Lindisfarne, at Canterbury, in Gaul, and at Rome; Born in Northumberland in 634.

St. Wilfrid was an outstanding personage of his day, extremely capable and possessed of unbounded courage, remaining firm in his convictions despite running afoul of civil and ecclesiastical authorities. He helped bring the discipline of the English Church into line with that of Rome. He was also a dedicated pastor and a zealous and skilled missionary.



### September 29, 2024 26<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time – Yr B

Gesù nel Vangelo indica il servizio come via della vera grandezza. Egli ha appena annunciato la sua passione e gli apostoli, per quanto ciò possa sembrare inverosimile, si mettono a discutere chi di loro sarà il più grande nel futuro regno, Gesù capovolge le loro prospettive: il primo nel suo regno è colui che nell'umiltà sa farsi servo di tutti, specialmente dei piccoli, degli ultimi e dei dimenticati. Se per molti riuscire nella vita significa accumulare una fortuna, salire sul podio degli onori, raccogliere solo le rose della vita, Cristo proclama che non esiste vera grandezza se non nel dono di sé disinteressato e nel generoso servizio ai fratelli. Come? Lottando contro l'orgoglio, ripulendo il cuore da ogni desiderio di metterci in vista e prendendo come modello Gesù Cristo che cammina avendo davanti a sé la meta della vera gloria, quella promessa dal Padre. L'umiltà del servizio è quindi la via indicata da Cristo per essere nel mondo lievito buono che fa fermentare l'umanità e la fraternità. Ritorniamo sul cammino che lui ci indica: convertirci dall'amore "che prende" all'amore "che serve", perché solo chi veramente ama è capace di servire in umiltà e creare futuro, speranza, novità..

The readings of today challenge us to recognize the work of the Spirit in others, to be inclusive and tolerant. In the gospel, the disciples try to stop someone who was driving out demons just like them. In contrast to his disciples, Jesus was able to recognize the goodness and the presence of the Spirit in anyone. Like the disciples, we can refuse to acknowledge God's good work in the lives of others because they are not 'one of us', because they belong to a different church or religion or ethnic group. We can also be dismissive of the good someone else is doing simply because it is not the way we would have done it, forgetting that the Holy Spirit works in many diverse ways in people's lives.

The mark of a true disciple of Jesus Christ is an attitude of encouragement, tolerance, compassion and acceptance of the gifts of others.
