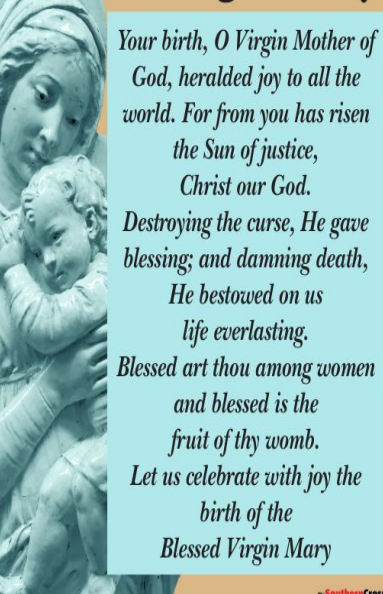

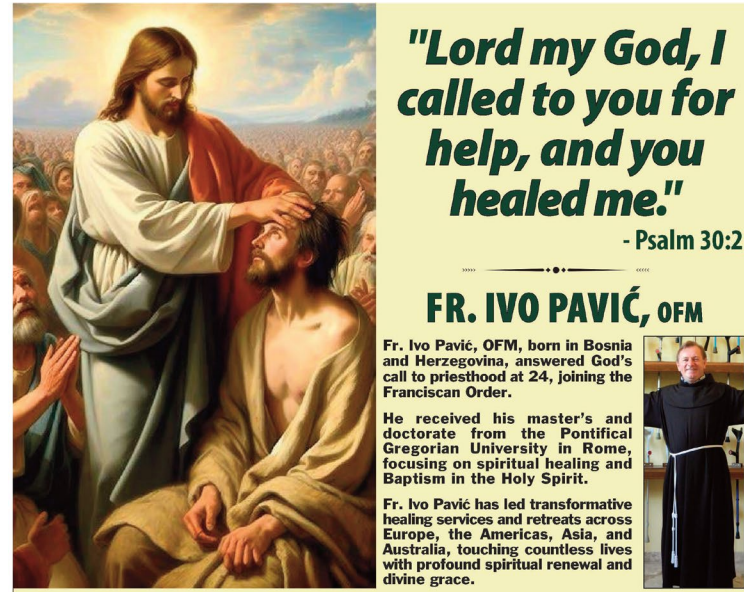

"Se tuo fratello commetterà una colpa..." Gesù colloca la correzione fraterna nel cuore della vita comunitaria. Essa non nasce dal bisogno di avere ragione, ma dalla responsabilità per l'altro, per non lasciarlo solo nel suo errore. Prima ancora del peccato, viene la relazione. Il percorso indicato da Gesù è graduale e delicato: dal faccia, dove la parola può ancora salvare senza umiliare, al coinvolgimento della comunità non per schiacciare ma sempre per sostenere e guadagnare il fratello. Il linguaggio è sorprendente: il fratello è un bene prezioso, che non si può rischiare di perdere e la correzione è un atto di custodia.

"If your brother sins..." Jesus places fraternal correction at the heart of community life. It arises not from the need to be right, but from responsibility for others, so as not to leave them alone in their error. Relationships come before sin. The path indicated by Jesus is gradual and delicate: from face-to-face, where the word can still save without humiliating, to community involvement, not to crush but always to support and win over our brothers. The language is surprising: our brothers are precious, something we cannot risk losing, and correction is an act of compassion.

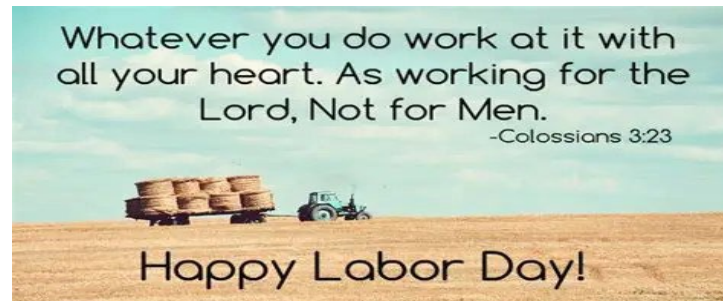
