ITINERARY*

June 28, 2025 TORONTO-OTTAWA-ST HYACINTHE

Depart from Toronto to Ottawa, the capital of Canada. We will drive by around the city, Rideau Canal, The National Gallery of Canada, Parliament Hill and many more. After the city tour, we will attend anticipated mass at Notre Dame Basilica. We will proceed to St Hyacinthe to check in with our hotel.

June 29, 2025 ST HYANCINTHE-RIVIERE-DU-LOUP-FREDERICTON

After breakfast we head east of the St. Lawrence River to New Brunswick. This route is dubbed as the "Lighthouse Route". Be ready for whale watching as we pass by the South Shore of the St. Lawrence River. Dinner and check in hotel.

June 30, 2025 FREDERICTON, NEW BRUNSWICK TO HALIFAX, NOVA SCOTIA

After breakfast we depart towards Aulac, New Brunswick. We will meet our local guide at Halifax Shopping Centre and proceed to Peggy's Cove. The tour continues to the Halifax Public Gardens. The gardens are the oldest Victorian style gardens in Canada. From the Public Gardens tour, we will continue to drive by Citadel Hill stop for photo shoot only. Citadel Hill, now a National Historic Site, is a large stone fort constructed between 1826 and 1858. A great photo opportunity to see Halifax Harbour and the downtown area. Dinner and check in hotel.

July 1, 2025 HALIFAX to CHARLOTTETOWN, PEI

Depart for Truro to connect with the Trans Canada Highway heading west to Masstown Market. Travel from Masstown to the Confederation Bridge connecting New Brunswick with Prince Edward Island. The bridge was constructed between 1993 and 1997, is fourteen kilometers long and has the distinction as being the longest bridge in the world that spans frozen water.

Once on the PEI side, stop at Gateway Village and visit Shop and Play, one of the best locations for everything Anne of Green Gables. Proceed to North Shore of the island, and the community of Cavendish. Enroute you will see the birthplace of Anne Gables, Lucy Maud Montgomery. Visit is planned for the Anne of Green Gables National Historic Site. Once the farm of Lucy M. Montgomery's uncle, the farmhouse has been remodeled to resemble the farmhouse in the story, Anne of Green Gables. You can also walk along Lover's Lane or the Haunted Wood. Drive through the National Park and view the red stone and sand beaches. A stop will be made in the Acadian Village of North Rustico where the lobster industry and the ways lobster are caught, close to the fishing boats. From North Rustico travel to Charlottetown – the birthplace of Confederation. Highlights of the city tour includes Victoria Park, Fanning Bank, Confederation Centre of the Arts, St. Dunstan Cathedral and Province House. Dinner and check in hotel.

July 2, 2025 PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND-MONCTON- SAINT JOHN, NEW BRUNSWICK

Depart hotel to Confederation Bridge and arrive at Gateway Village then proceed to Hopewell Rocks Provincial Park. Hopewell Rock, home the Flowerpot Rocks located on the Bay of Fundy. The average tide at this location is thirty-six feet. You can walk on the ocean floor if it will be low tide during the visit.

Depart from Hopewell Rocks and travel to Saint John. Proceed to Reversing Rapids, where depending on the tide of the Bay of Fundy, you may see the follow of the Saint John River going upstream. Dinner and check in to hotel.

July 3, 2025 SAINT JOHN-QUEBEC

Depart from Saint John and head to Quebec driving by the Hartland Covered Bridge. Hartland's 1282-foot-long covered bridge is the longest covered bridge in the world. It was constructed by Hartland Bridge Company. Also know as "Kissing Bridge," Wish Bridge," the bridge of romance and the bridge of luck. Now, it is closed indefinitely. Dinner and check in hotel.

July 4, 2025 TROIS-RIVIERES-STE-QUEBEC CITY-ANNE DE BEAUPRE-MONTREAL-TORONTO

Depart to attend mass at Notre-Dame de Quebec Basilica Cathedral in Quebec City. Free time to look around Chateau Frontenac. Proceed to visit Sainte Anne de Beaupre and do the Way of the Cross and Scala Santa (if open). Continue to visit St. Joseph's Oratory of Mount Royal in Montreal. Homeward bound, stopping at Big Apple time permitting.
